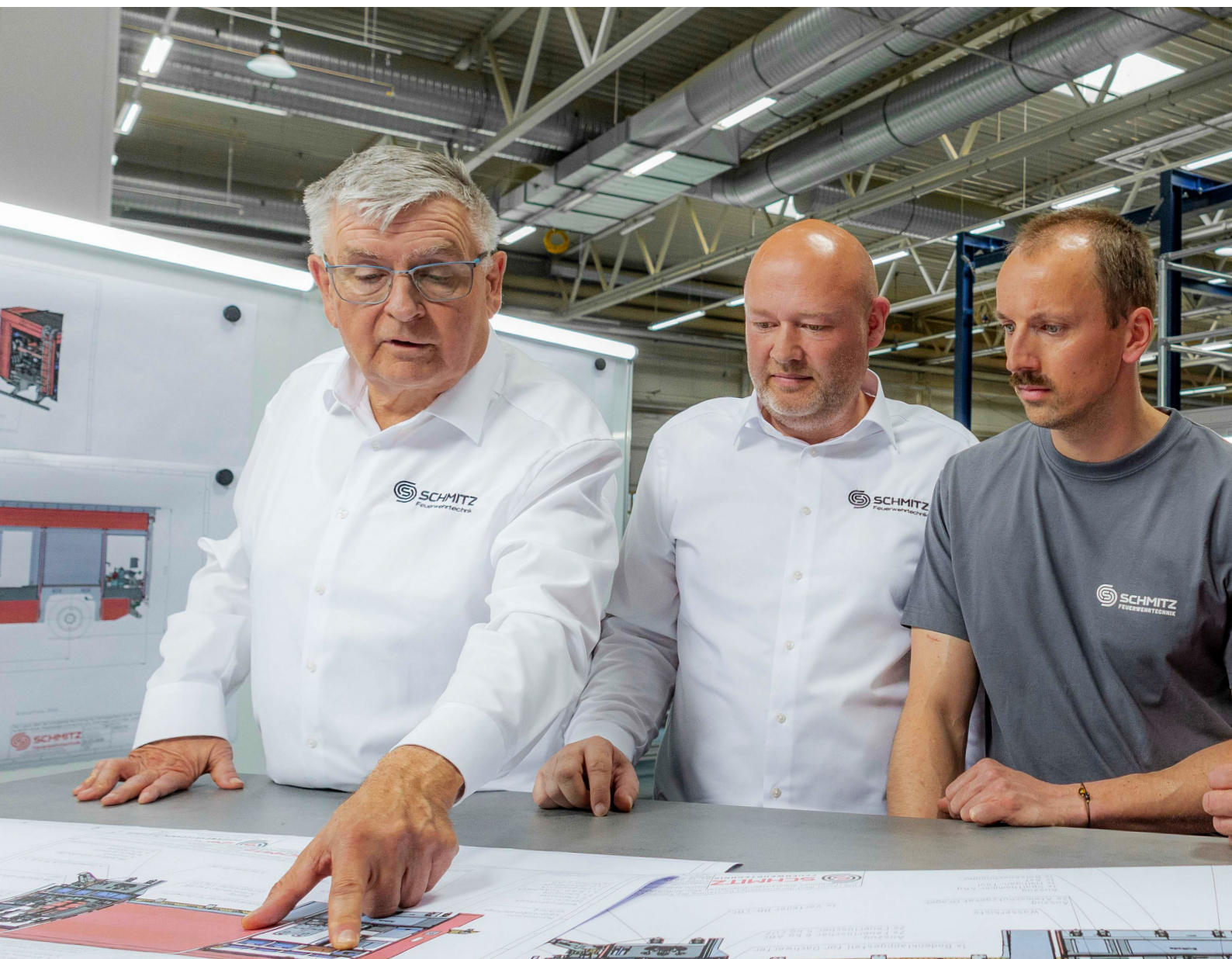

Centrifugal fire pump

The key element of every fire-fighting vehicle is the centrifugal fire pump. It can be supplied in the following output levels:

- FPN 10-2000
- FPN 10-3000

Positive-pressure proportioning systems as per DIN EN 16327 are also optionally available with various ratings.

All fire-fighting equipment can be adapted to the customer's needs.



CAN bus control unit

A CAN bus control unit ensures intuitive operation.

Large buttons with symbols and plain text markings provide a simple interface for operators.

A display gives a quick overview of the vehicle's status.





LIGHTING CONCEPT

Safety in every situation

An optimised lighting concept provides additional safety in every situation.

Seeing and being seen is all-important.

Rear-end protection can be installed in addition to the special signal system.

The yellow lights can be augmented by a dot-matrix display that shows special messages or instructions to motorists.



AMBIENT LIGHTING

Optimal illumination of the surroundings

Excellent illumination is provided in the work areas around our vehicles.

These illuminated areas allow firefighters to work safely and efficiently even under difficult lighting conditions.

We have paid special attention to reducing shadow formation.

We use these lighting technologies to create uniform illumination that makes critical areas of an operation clearly visible.

In this way we enable firefighters to work quickly and effectively even in challenging scenarios.
